Subject: Declaration of Anti-Corruption Intent and the Non-Acceptance of Gifts and Presents of any Kind in Connection with the Performance of Duties (No Gift Policy)

“Health Systems Research Institute (HSRI): Integrity and Transparency against Corruption”

Fiscal Year B.E. 2569

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I, Dr.Supakit Sirilak, along with all staffs of the Health Systems Research Institute (HSRI), hereby jointly declare our intention that the Health Systems Research Institute (HSRI) is an organization where all staffs shall not accept gifts or presents of any kind in connection with the performance of duties whether during, before, or after the performance of such duties where the acceptance may lead to corruption and misconduct, both in the present and in the future.

We shall adhere firmly to the principal institutions of the nation, namely, the Nation, Religion, and the Monarchy. We resolve to be virtuous, conducting ourselves in a respectable profession with integrity and honesty as our core principle, upholding our dignity and human worth. We will stand up for what is right and perform our duties lawfully and righteously. We shall not commit fraud against the state, shall not tolerate corruption in any form, and shall refrain from seeking personal gain through our career.

We shall not accept gifts or presents of any kind in connection with the performance of our duties (No Gift Policy) and shall have no conflict between personal and public interests. We shall not accept assets or any other benefits quantifiable in money from any person, other than those rightfully received under the law, rules, or regulations issued under the authority of legal provisions, based on ethical practices, in accordance with the criteria and limits set by the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC).

We shall jointly foster a culture of integrity within the organization and perform our duties to the best of our ability, with accuracy, transparency, and fairness, in line with the six core management values: Honesty, Unity, Accountability, Scrutiny, Transparency, and Focus

on Achievement. We shall do what is right, including conduct ourselves according to the ethical standards for government officials and the Ministry of Public Health Code of Conduct.

Furthermore, we shall conduct ourselves in accordance with His Majesty the King's footsteps, inheriting and continuing the royal aspirations, preserving and extending the knowledge of the King, and living our lives according to the Philosophy of Sufficiency Economy, standing alongside integrity for the stability, prosperity, and sustainability of the Kingdom of Thailand.
